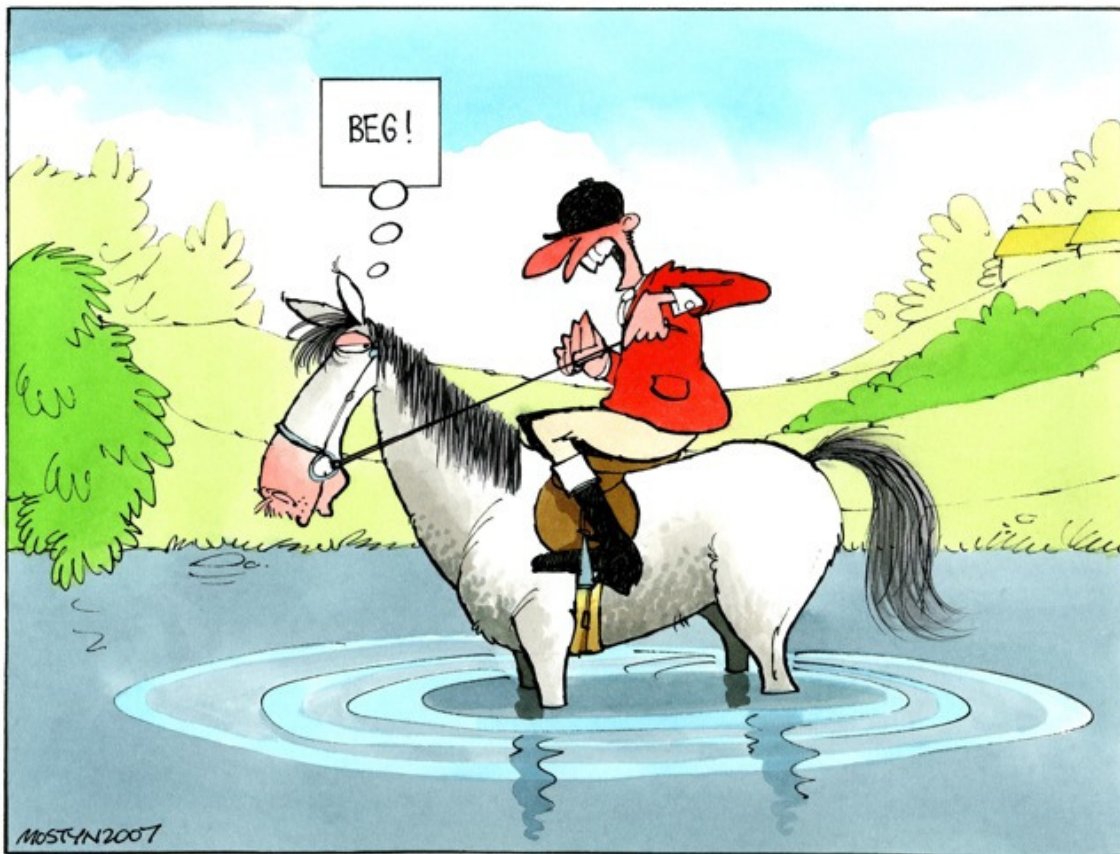

# WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

**Who should come?** Anyone who enjoys hacking across country in a relaxed and friendly atmosphere.

**Where will we ride?** Many different places. This is a wonderful opportunity to explore the best riding country in Southern Ontario. See the **Summer Fixture Card**, or visit our blog at <http://eglintoncaledon.blogspot.com> for details.

**What type of horse should I have?** Anything from an old western trail horse to young event prospects, to field hunters, to a kid's pony. Your horse should be fit.

**Is jumping required?** No, but jumping may be an option.

**Can I use a western saddle?** Sure.

**When are the rides?** Most Wednesdays and Saturdays through June, July and August. The rides start promptly at **10:00 am** so plan to arrive early. The rides will last 1½ to 2 hours. Although dress is casual, riders must wear protective head gear.

**What about lunch?** Plan to join the group for lunch. It may be a picnic, a gathering in a local pub or restaurant, or pot luck, etc.

**Wednesday, June 2:** *Host:* Ron House, (519) 927-5483, Kirkwood House Farms, 16590 McLaren Road, Caledon.

*Directions:* North on Hwy. 10 to the Grange Sideroad, Caledon, turn left (west), then follow road to right (don't go under RR bridge) where it becomes McLaren Road, to the first drive on left at bend.

**Saturday, June 5:** *Host:* Christine Gracey, (519) 925-5319, at Mono Cliffs Park.

*Directions:* Follow Hwy. 10 north of Orangeville to County Road 8 at Camilla. Turn right (east) on County Road 8. Continue through a sharp turn to the left (north) to stop sign in Mono Centre. Turn right (east) and continue to the first road north, 3<sup>rd</sup> Line E.H.S. Make a left turn (north). The parking lot is on the left (west) side of 3<sup>rd</sup> Line E.H.S.

*Directions:* North on Airport Road to Coolihan Sideroad, turn right (east).

*Directions to Ride:* Hwy. 10 north from Shelburne to Dufferin Road 9 (Dundalk). Turn right on Dufferin Road 9 to Dufferin Road 2 (2<sup>nd</sup> road). Turn left on Dufferin Road 2 to 4<sup>th</sup> Line. Turn left on 4<sup>th</sup> Line to Road 41A. Turn left and park on the side of the road.

*Directions to BBQ:* 260360 Southgate 26, Proton Station. From Road 41A, go west to South Line (3 roads), turn right on South Line to end (East Back Line), turn left, then immediate right to 200 Sideroad. Cross Hwy. 10 to 3<sup>rd</sup> house on left (south). Park in the drive if you have a small trailer. Park on the road if you have a large rig!
